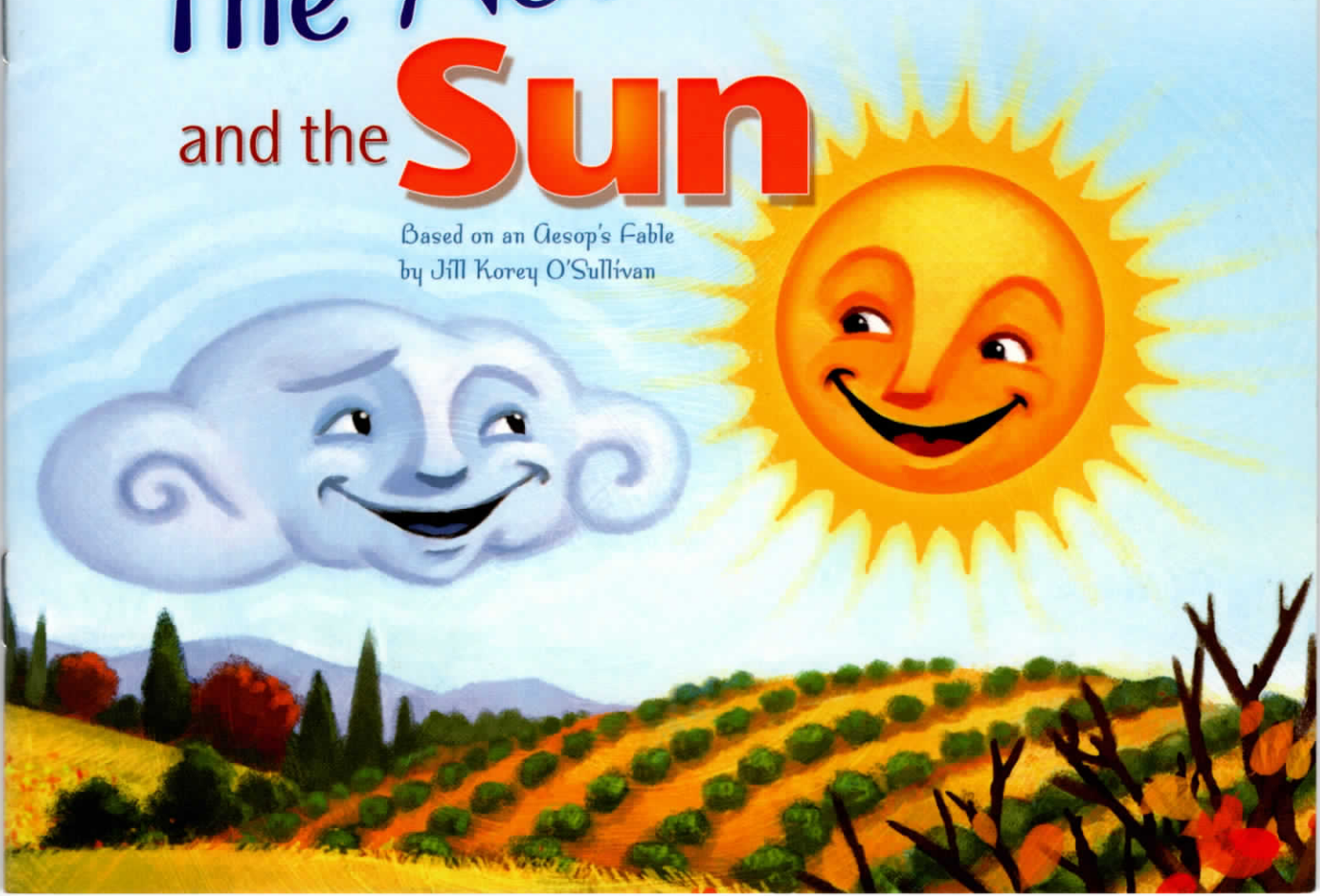


The North Wind

by Jill Korey O'Sullivan



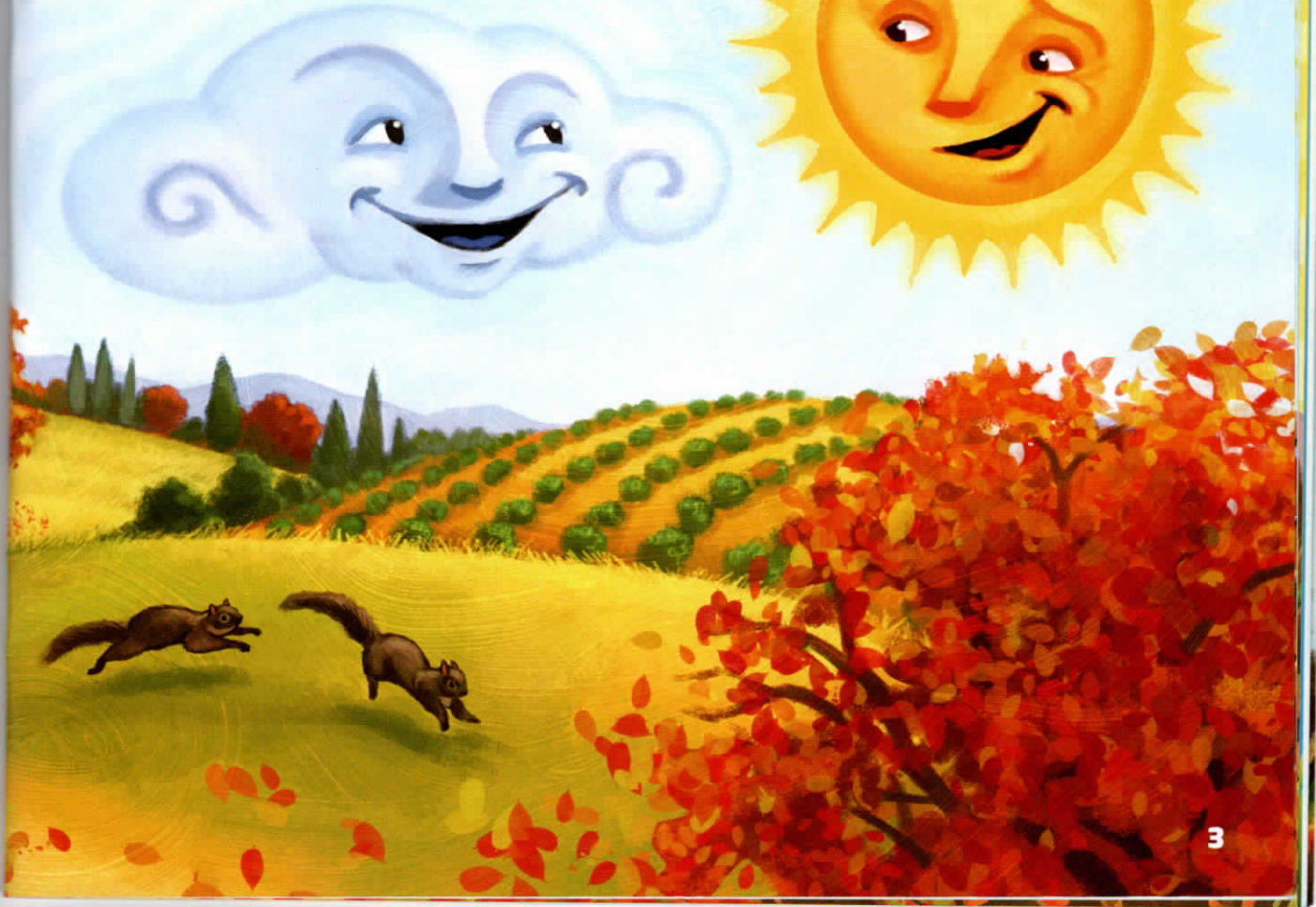
One day Sun and the North Wind

Sun says, 'Really? Show me.'



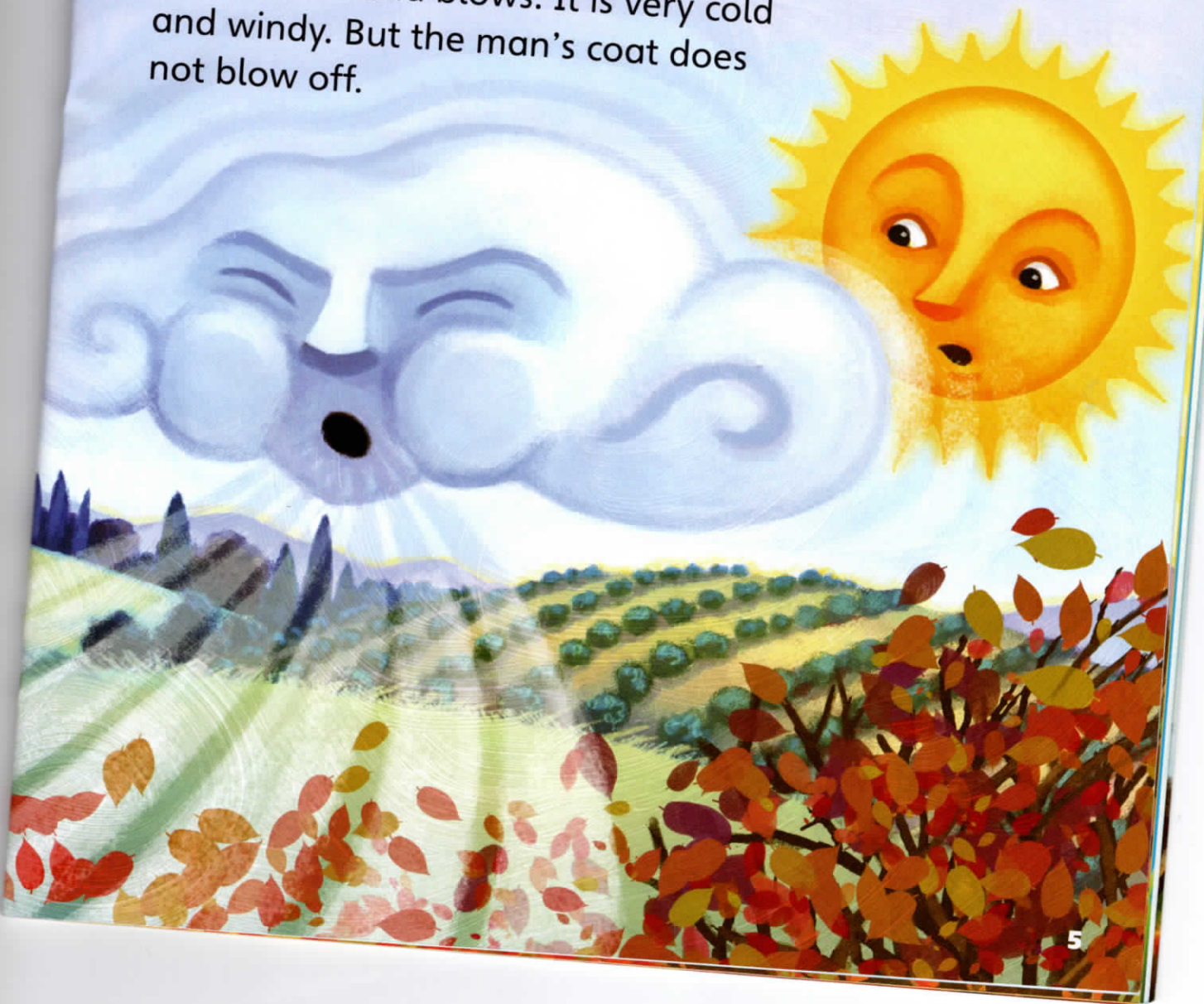
Wind blows.

'It is windy, but the man is still wearing his coat,' says Sun.

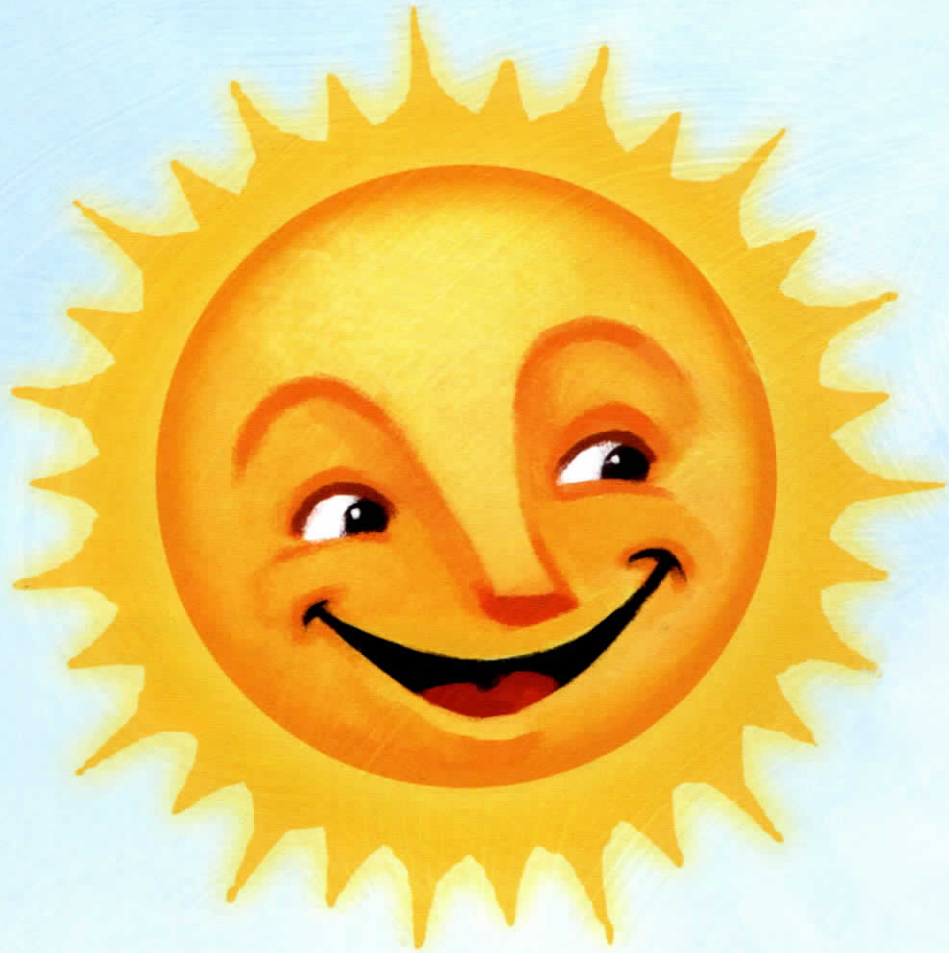
'I can blow it off!' says Wind.
